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| 1. A: Nǐ jiālide dōngxi dōu dào le ma? | Have all your household things arrived? |
| B: Yǒude dào le, yǒude hái méi dào. | Some have arrived, and some haven't arrived yet. |
| 2. C: Zhèxiè zázhi nǐ kàn le ma? | Have you read these magazines? |
| D: Zhèxiè zázhi, yǒude wǒ kàn le, yǒude wǒ hái méi kàn. | Some of these magazines I've read, and some I haven't read yet. |
| 3. B: Zuótiān wǒ mǎile yìdiǎn pánziwǎn. | Yesterday I bought some dishes. |
| 4. *A: Nín mǎi shénme le? | What did you buy? |
| B: Wǒ mǎi fànwǎn le. | I bought rice bowls. |
| 5. A: Nǐ mǎile duōshao? | How many did you buy? |
| B: Wǒ mǎile shíge fànwǎn, shíge dà pánzi. | I bought ten rice bowls and ten large plates. |
| 6. A: Nàxiè pánziwǎn shì shénme yánsède? | What color are those dishes? |
| B: Shì lán de. | They're blue ones. |
| A: À, wǒ yě xǐhuan lán de. | Oh, I like blue ones too. |
| 7. **A: Shì zài shénme dìfang mǎide? | Where were they bought? |
| B: Shì zài Dìyī Gōngsī mǎide. | They were bought at the First Company. |
| 8. B: Tāmen mǎide dōngxi zhēn hǎo. | The things they sell are really nice. |
| 9. B: Tāmen mǎide pánziwǎn, yǒude zhēn hǎokàn. Kěshì guǐ yìdiǎn. | Some of the dishes they sell are really beautiful. But they are a little expensive. |

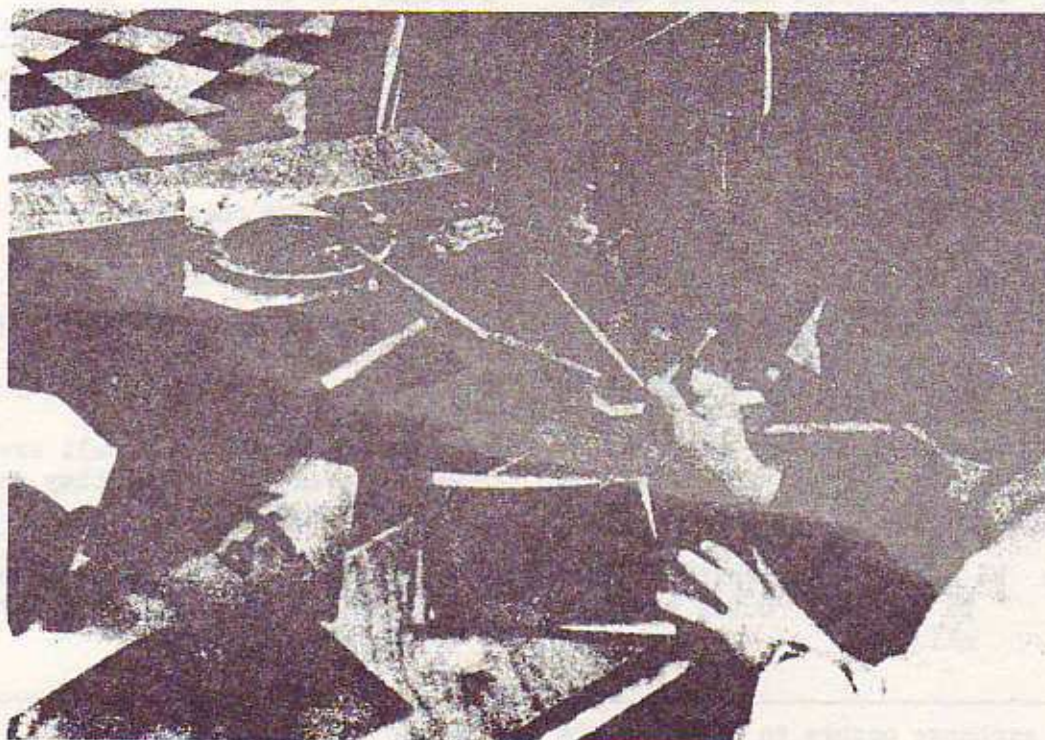
